Carew II offers a warm and welcoming atmosphere to anyone from within the local community of Inner East Belfast wishing to learn new skills, update their skills/qualifications or just build their confidence by taking their first course or qualification.

We understand the concerns many adults face when making a decision to return to learning. For this reason our staff - who are mainly local people and have personal experience of returning to training - are encouraging and very supportive.

The Centre also provides two playgroups, a crèche, toddler group, after school facilities, a youth project, an advice and referral service and a summer scheme. Our childcare services are staffed by fully trained, qualified and highly motivated and committed personnel.



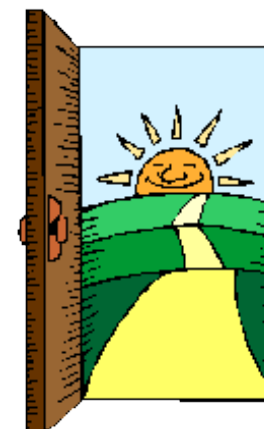
